

TROOP 215 PERMISSION SLIP

We will return the scouts home approximately at 9:00p.m. Saturday evening.

Cost: \$15 for the event

What to pack: sleeping bag with liner, Scout Uniform, sleeping pads, hat, 1 pair of work gloves, 2 extra pairs of socks, windbreak/rain gear, one change of clothes NO COTTON, nalgene water bottle, pocket knife, mess kit, flash light/head lamp, boy scout book, mosquito head net, hiking boots, personal first aid kit, Scout Handbook in gallon zip lock bag (see your Scout Handbook for recommended contents). PARENTS this is Alaska, please check the weather forecast and ensure that your son is packed appropriately. In addition: rubber boots/waders, life jacket, baseball hat, and safety/polarized glasses, fishing rod and reel, age 16 and above need a fishing license.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived, and in view of the fact that the Boy Scouts of America is a voluntary educational organization, and having full confidence that every reasonable precaution will be taken to ensure the safety and well-being of my son's participation during this activity, I give my son permission to go on this activity. I give the adult leaders of Boy Scout Troop 215 permission to administer/request medical assistance for my son if required. Permission is also granted for emergency transport of my son and/or the attention of medical personnel in the administration of aid.
